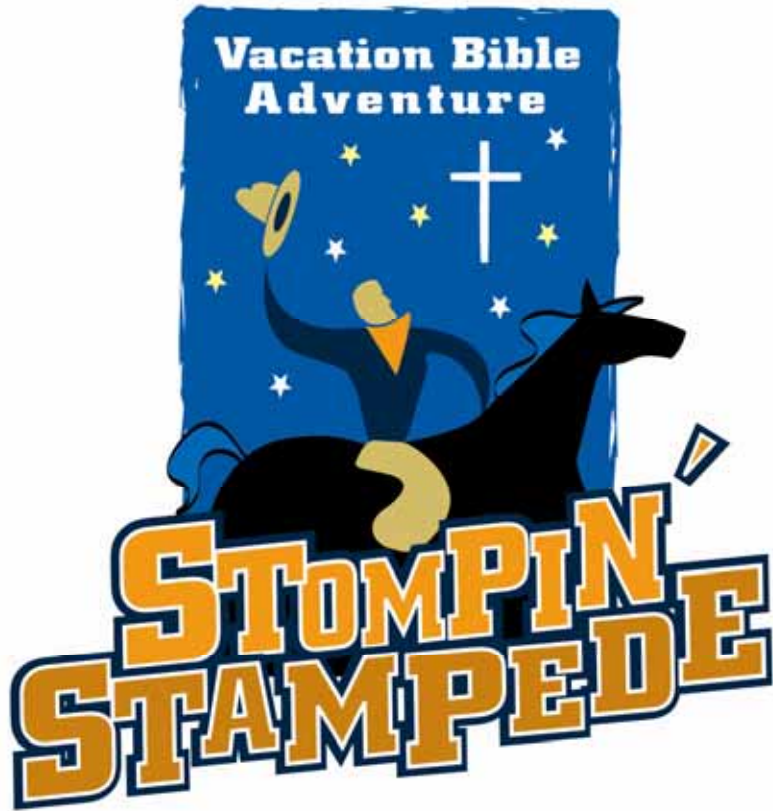

from the pastor

Jesus had 12 disciples, right?

Actually, that's not true.

The Bible says He literally had hundreds of disciples for much of His ministry. People who followed Him and tried to do what He said. But 12 of them made up a very special, close group.

An inner circle, if you will.

When all the other disciples left him, in John 6:67, He asked the 12, "Will you also go away?" And they did not. They stuck with Him till the end and beyond, all except Judas.

There's something to be said about a small, tight knit group.

On any given Sunday we have about 220 people here ... and I'm thankful for every one.

But in a crowd that size, its easy to fall through the cracks, to get lost, to fall away without anyone noticing.

Kind of like those hundreds of disciples.

But here we offer everyone the chance to get into that smaller, close knit group. We've called them "Sunday School classes," but really, they're "life groups" ... people in the same stage of life you are, who together form a smaller, closer knit group of followers of Jesus who hear more about him than you can learn from a Sunday morning sermon. Each Sunday School class, or [LifeGroup](#), has a teacher, who is really like a mini-pastor for that small part of the flock.

What's neat about our [LifeGroups](#) is that they are available for every age from 3 years of age to 103!

And I love our [LifeGroups](#) because I've found that, just like the 12 disciples, their people are more likely to stay committed to Christ through the hard times, because they've got each other to lean on, and like the song says, "we all need some body to lean on!"

Sunday, July 17, CIC will begin offering [LifeGroups](#) after church, as well as before church like we already do. So, whether you're an early riser or a sleepy head, you and your kids can get involved in [LifeGroups](#) and learn more about Christ, while feeling part of that smaller band of (12) disciples.
