## from the pastor

Shortly after skydiving, white water rafting and exploring Arches National Park, I was riding with one of our elders, Paul Loy, out west when I saw a nearby mountain cliff and expressed my desire to go rappelling down one some day; to which Paul replied, "You want to experience everything, don't you?"

As a 26 year old I thought about it and truthfully answered, "Yeah." After all, who wants to go through life and miss anything?

Now, nine years later, I realize that's impossible: too much to do, too little time, too many other responsibilities.

That could be depressing—and it should be if you're not a Christian.

God's Word warns that this is it for you (Psalm 73). So, if you're not going to accept Christ, then go for it all now ... whatever you wish to do, let nothing stop you from doing it now ... grab for everything, live for today, eat and drink ... for tomorrow you may lose the chance forever.

But for the Christian man or woman, we need not fear leaving experiences unexperienced. All those things you wanted to do, that you didn't get around to ... you'll have the freedom to experience there.

Scripture doesn't tell us everything about the life to come, but if you think you'll just be sitting in an eternal church service you have no idea how wrong you are (check out my web log on this topic).

That's why, as a Christian, we can say "No," to some things now ... its called "laying up treasures in heaven." So, Christian, fulfill your dull responsibilities; give away your time and money; give your life not to a personal quest, but rather to Christ's purpose.

In the end, you'll discover you haven't missed out on any joy ... instead, you've gained the ultimate experience.
