Sometimes we feel we need to become like the world in order to win them. "If I don't have a drink with the guys, laugh at their dirty jokes, use a little profanity like they do, look lecherously at the girls like everyone else does, they'll just feel I have nothing in common with them, and won't listen to me about the gospel."

Nothing could be further from the truth!

Just this week I was talking to someone who admits he isn't a Christian, but he made the same comment I've heard often. "The Christians I know go out and do the same things I do. At least I'm not being a hypocrite."

You see, the world expects us to be different. They expect you to turn down the shot of whiskey, to talk a different talk, to not laugh at their jokes, etc. Oh, they might rib you about it ... they might even curse you because of it, but they will be disappointed if you cave in. They desperately want to see somebody whose walk matches their talk.

We should reach out to the lost. We should love them. We should not be arrogant or unkind. We should even speak to their needs where they are, using words and methods they can understand.

Paul said we are to be "all things to all men." But we are also to let them "see our good works, that they may glorify your Father who is in heaven."

Are you being the difference they need, or are you just another hypocrite who has disappointed their hopes? Don't be afraid to be different ... if you aren't, you'll never make a difference!
