from the pastor

When I was in high school, I was shocked when I found out that my cousin, who was also in high school, thought that we lived inside the earth instead of on it. I thought, "What are they teaching those kids in Louisville!"

I'm sure, or at least I surely hope, that the Jefferson County Pubic Schools she attended had taught the basics about gravity, the globe, etc. But evidently she wasn't listening. Her world view blinded her, or deafened her, to the truth.

The greatest danger when we read scripture or think about God is "eisogesis" which means, "making the Bible say what we think it should say." If we're not careful, we come to God and scripture with our own preconceived ideas, and we make sure the Bible confirms what we already think.

When was the last time something you read in scripture shook your world ... made you realize you were wrong about something?

Often we get weird ideas about God, heaven, sin or life in general from all kinds of sources other than Scripture. Some of these ideas can even come from cults or Satanism; but if a friend says it, a teacher, or we get the idea forwarded to us on the Internet, and it sounds good or makes us feel good, we accept it and believe it.

Then, when we read the Bible and it seems to contradict it, we say, "Well, obviously the Bible can't mean that," and we ignore what the Bible is saying.

My cousin finally accepted the truth that we live on the earth, not inside it. We must either accept the Bible's pronouncements or instead let our own preconceptions tell us who God is and what He says ... making our God be what we think He should be.

Read your Bible ... let it shake your world view ... and let its truth set you free.
