## from the pastor

One of the saddest thoughts when tragedies such as 9/11 or Katrina strike is that many of the folks who die in these catastrophes do not go to heaven. Instead, they move on to experience the greater tragedy of eternity.

When we think about the future fate that awaits the wicked, it's easy sometimes to doubt the justice of God.

What if God punishes someone disproportionately for their deeds? What if God gives one barely an opportunity to repent, but showers another with multiple chances?

We all should have natural empathy with the lost ... we should be able to put ourselves mentally in their shoes. We should be able to think ... this could be me. When we think that way, our heart's desire becomes to save as many as we possibly can. It's good to know that this desire also is shared by God.

First Timothy 2:1-4 tells us that God desires, or wishes, for all to be saved. Ezekiel tells us God takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked. Sometimes we are repulsed by the idea of eternal punishment.

It's nice to know that God feels the same way we do about it. Hell is necessary because God is Just. But like a jury member who hates to convict someone but knows she has to uphold the law, God will do what He must ... and His judgment will be proven to be incontrovertible.

Ultimately, when thinking about future torment we must remember to trust God. Hell is a frightening prospect ... but its existence, its torment and its permanence is irrefutably declared in scripture. But, so is God's righteousness, love, goodness and wisdom. God is holy, which means He does all things well.
