Years ago I heard David Letterman say that every night his biggest fear is that people are going to get smart and realize he isn't talented after all. I relate to that. I've often thought, "If this church had a real pastor, it could really go places."

I hate Pastor's Appreciation Month because it puts the spotlight on me, and, when I look at me, I don't see anybody along the lines of great pastors I've known. When I hear people praise my efforts, I seriously wonder if they're talking about the same guy I know!
