from the pastor

You'll probably hear me pounding a lot over the next few months about the importance of each one of us daily spending some quiet time reading the Bible. I'll be talking a lot about this because I have the sneaking suspicion that is not what most of us are doing.

I know our time is valuable ... And, if reading the Bible daily was something that was just mildly helpful or nice, I wouldn't ask you to do it. Rather, it is something that will change your life as no other one thing you do daily can.

I'm convinced that if each of us realized the absolutely atomic power contained in God's Word, no one could steal from us that 10 minutes daily when we sit down to read it.

The nation just recently mourned the death of Rosa Parks, the great lady who almost single handedly started the American Civil Rights movement by standing up to legal discrimination against African-American people. What gave this little, quiet seamstress the courage to do such an amazing thing? In her own words: "As a child I learned from the Bible to trust in God and not be afraid ... I remember finding such comfort and peace reading the Bible. Its teaching became a way of life and helped me in dealing with my day-to-day problems."

In fact, Mrs. Parks read and memorized scripture for years before that historic day when she wouldn't move to the back of the bus.

Abraham Lincoln and Ronald Reagan both gave speeches about the magnificence of the Scripture. Thomas Jefferson ordered Bibles to be read in the public schools. These great people weren't just wasting time with a paperback novel—they all realized that the Bible is the most significant, powerful book ever written.
